

Bristol Free School: Sixth Form Contract



The aim of the Sixth Form contract is to ensure that you achieve your best in your chosen courses and act as a positive role model at Bristol Free School.

Your Part

A) As a member of a subject group I will:

1. Take an active and positive role in my learning
2. Work hard to achieve at least my Target Minimum Grades (TMG)
3. Attend and be punctual for all my lessons
4. Hand in assignments/coursework/homework by set deadlines and to the highest possible standard
5. Use the ICT network only to support my learning
6. Ask staff for help when necessary, in order to gain the maximum benefit from the support available

B) As a member of a tutor group I will:

1. Attend and be punctual for registration and other appointments with my tutor
2. Make best use of private study periods
3. Attend the weekly assembly for my year group
4. Ensure that my parent(s)/carers(s) follow the School's absence reporting system if I am absent from school
5. Inform my tutor of any issues affecting my learning including change of contact details
6. Take an active part in the life of the Sixth Form and Tutor Group activities

C) As a member of Bristol Free School Sixth Form I will:

1. Behave in a courteous and polite manner towards every person in the School
2. Treat all areas of the school with respect
3. Follow the Sixth Form dress code at all times - including during exam periods
4. Wear my lanyard at all times in school
5. Aim for 100% attendance record to registration and lessons
6. Ensure that I do not exceed 12 hours paid part time work per week
7. Take responsibility for my actions
8. Wear the dress code correctly

D) I understand that failure to adhere to these expectations may result in some or all of the following:

1. My parent(s)/carer(s) will be contacted
2. I may be sent home by the Assistant Headteacher in charge of Sixth Form
3. Be placed in Sixth Form detention on Friday afternoon between 3.00pm and 4.30pm
4. I may be removed from lessons and placed under the supervision of the Assistant Headteacher for the duration of the day
5. I may be placed on report (Green, Amber, Red)
6. I may be given further sanctions as enforced by the Assistant Headteacher in charge of Sixth Form
7. I may be placed on the Sixth Form CEC Policy, which may finally result in termination of study

Parent/Carer Part

A) To support the Sixth Former fully parents are expected to:

1. Follow the School's absence reporting system to notify any absence
2. Limit the student's number of hours paid outside work to 12 per week
3. Attend parent/carers meetings
4. Take interest and support the learning of the Sixth Former
5. Ensure that attendance is between 90% and 100%
6. Ensure that the student attends registration and assemblies
7. Ensure that the student leaves home dressed in line with the dress code and with their lanyard.

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The School's Part

A) Your subject teachers will:

1. Provide you with information about courses
2. Mark your work regularly
3. Give you feedback on your progress
4. Inform your Tutor/HOY/Head of Sixth Form of any concerns
5. Contact your parents/carers as required
6. Monitor your attendance to their subject
7. Welcome your views about their subject

B) Your Tutor will:

1. Monitor your overall progress
2. Take the register daily and monitor your attendance to all lessons
3. Provide advice and guidance on a range of issues
4. Provide enrichment in registration time
5. Talk to staff on your behalf
6. Guide you with UCAS applications and other progression routes.
7. Contact your parents/carers as required
8. Pass on messages from staff

C) You can expect from the Sixth Form:

1. Staff to be polite and to treat you courteously
2. A well equipped study area to assist you with your studies
3. Access to a wide range of resources within your courses and the LRC
4. A stimulating working environment and good social facilities
5. Advice, guidance and support on a range of issues
6. To be consulted on a range of Sixth Form teaching and other issues
7. Parents/carers to be contacted if your attendance falls below acceptable levels
8. A Sixth Form Council to represent your views and opinions
