

Dress Code Contract

Our dress code allows considerable freedom whilst ensuring everyone's appearance is both relatively casual and respectable. Obvious things are listed below:

- Trainers and jeans are acceptable but no branded clothing, including sportswear
- No shorts, jeggings, playsuits, jump suits
- Skirts must be no more than 10cm above the knee
- Underwear must not be on display
- No large inappropriate logos or branding should be worn
- Aggressive/severe body piercing and tattoos are not acceptable
- No strappy or strapless tops (shoulders and décolletage must be covered)
- Midriffs must be covered
- No espadrilles or flip-flops
- No hats or caps to be worn in school
- Hoodies may be worn with the hood down
- No leggings with short skirts.

Outlandish or extreme hairstyles must be avoided.

This is not an exhaustive list; the application of common sense is advised.

Sixth form students are role models for students across the school. They look up to you and aspire one day to be in your shoes. Those shoes need to be smart and clean.

The FINAL DECISION as to whether a student is appropriately dressed rests with the School's Senior Team.
